

## PERSONALIZED HEALING PROMISES

*These have been edited from the scriptures to read in the first person so they may become a personal prayer, communication with God, or a declaration of God's Goodness and Promise.*

**Exodus 15:26 YOU ARE THE LORD WHO HEALS ME.**

**Exodus 23:25,26** I will worship and serve You, O LORD my GOD, for You will bless my food and water. **You will take away sickness from me. I will not miscarry or be barren. You will fulfill the number of my days.**

**Deuteronomy 7:14,15** Your purpose is that we shall be blessed above all people. There shall not be male or female barren among us or among our cattle. And **You, O LORD, will take away from us all sickness, and will not inflict on us any of the terrible diseases** we knew in Egypt.

**Jeremiah 30:1** *“For I will restore health to you, and I will heal you of your wounds,”* says the LORD...

**Jeremiah 33:6** *“Behold, I will bring health and healing; I will heal My people and will reveal to you the abundance of peace and truth.”*

**Psalm 103:1-5** Bless the LORD, O my soul, and all that is within me, bless Your holy Name. Bless the LORD, O my soul, and forget not all Your benefits; You forgive all my iniquities and **heal all my diseases**. You redeem my life from destruction and crown me with loving-kindness and tender mercies. You satisfy my mouth with good things so that **my youth is renewed like the eagle's**.

**Psalm 73:26** My flesh and my heart may fail, but **GOD, You are the strength of my heart and my portion forever.**

**Psalm 107:20** **You sent Your Word and healed me, and delivered me from my destructions.**

**Psalm 119:93** I will never forget Your precepts, for by them **You have restored my joy and health.**

**Psalm 147:3** **You heal my broken heart and bind up my wounds.**

**Proverbs 4:20-22** I will give attention to Your Words and incline my ear to Your Sayings. I will not let them depart from my sight; but keep them in the midst of my heart. For **they are life to me as I discover them, and health to all my flesh.**

**Malachi 4:2** I will honor Your Name, for You, **the Sun of Righteousness, shall arise with healing in Your wings.** And I shall go out and leap with joy like a calf released from the stall.

**Isaiah 57:18,19** You have seen my backsliding ways, but **You will heal me.** You will guide me and **restore comfort to me** and to my mourners, creating praise as the fruit of my lips; You offer peace, peace to me when I am afar off, and peace to me when I am near; and **You will heal me.**

**Isaiah 53:4,5** Surely **You have borne my weaknesses and carried my sorrows;** yet I considered You stricken by GOD, smitten by Him and afflicted. But You were wounded for my transgressions; You were bruised for my iniquities; the punishment that brought me peace was upon You; and **by Your wounds I myself am healed.**

**Matthew 8:16,17** And evening coming on, they brought to You many who had been possessed with demons. And You cast out the spirits with a Word, and **healed all who were sick** so that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Isaiah the prophet saying, **“You took on Yourself my infirmities and bore my sicknesses.”**

**Luke 4:18-21** *“The Spirit of the LORD is upon Me; because He has anointed Me to proclaim Good News to the poor. He has sent me to **heal the brokenhearted,** to proclaim **deliverance to the captives,** and **the recovery of sight to the blind,** to set **at liberty those who have been oppressed and crushed,** and to proclaim the year of the LORD’s favor.”* And rolling up the scroll, You returned it to the attendant and sat down. The eyes of all in the synagogue were fastened on You, Jesus, and You began by saying to them, *“Today this Scripture is fulfilled in your ears.”*

**Luke 5:12,13** *“LORD, if You are willing You can make me clean.”* Jesus, You reached out Your Hand and touched the man. **“I AM willing,” You said, “Be made clean!”** And instantly the leprosy disappeared.

**Matthew 28:18-20** And Jesus, You came and spoke, saying, **“All authority is given to Me in Heaven and on earth.** Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the Name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you. And, behold, I am with you always, even to the end of the age.”

**Matthew 9:5-7** *“Which is easier? To say, ‘Your sins are forgiven you’, or to say, ‘Arise and walk!’ But so that you may know that the **Son of Man has authority on earth to forgive sins,**”* then You said to the paralytic, **“Arise, take up your bed and go home.”** And he arose and departed to his house.

**Matthew 10:1,7,8** And when You had called to Yourself Your twelve disciples, **You gave them authority over unclean spirits,** to cast them out, **and to heal every kind**

**of sickness and every kind of disease.** ... *“And as you go, preach this message: ‘The Kingdom of Heaven is at hand.’ **Heal the sick, cleanse the lepers, raise the dead, cast out demons.** Freely you have received, freely give.”*

**Mark 3:14,15** And You ordained twelve, that they should be with You, and that You might send them out to preach, and to have **authority to heal sicknesses, and to cast out demons.**

**Mark 6:12,13** And they went out and proclaimed that men should repent. And they **cast out many demons, and anointed many who were sick with oil, and healed them.**

**Luke 9:1,2** And You called Your twelve disciples together and **gave them power and authority over all demons and to cure diseases.** And You sent them to proclaim the Kingdom of GOD and to **heal the sick.**

**Luke 10:1-3,9,17-20** And after these things, LORD, You appointed seventy others, and sent them two by two ahead of You into every city and place where You were about to come. Then You said to them, *“The harvest truly is great, but the laborers are few. Therefore ask the LORD of the harvest to send out laborers into His harvest fields. Go! Behold, I am sending you out as lambs among wolves. ... **heal the sick** and say to them, *The Kingdom of GOD has come near you!*”* .... And the seventy returned again with joy saying, “LORD, even the demons submit to us in Your Name.” And You said to them, *“I saw Satan fall like lightning from Heaven. Behold, **I give you authority** to tread on serpents and scorpions, and **over all the power of the enemy.** Nothing shall by any means hurt you. Yet do not rejoice in this, that the evil spirits are subject to you; rather rejoice because your names are written in Heaven.”*

**Mark 16:15-20** And You said, *“Go into all the world and proclaim the Good News to all creation. Whoever believes and is baptized will be saved, but whoever does not believe will be condemned. And **these signs will follow you who believe:** in My Name you will cast out demons; you will speak with new tongues; you will pick up serpents; and if you drink any deadly poison, it will not hurt you. **You will lay hands on the sick, and they will recover.**”* After speaking, You were taken up into Heaven, and sat at the right hand of GOD, Your Father. The disciples went out and preached everywhere, and **LORD, You worked with us and confirmed Your Word by the signs that followed.**

**John 14:12-14** *“I tell you the truth, **anyone who believes in Me shall do the works that I do, and shall do even greater works than these,** because I go to My Father. And whatever you may ask in My Name, that I will do, so that the Father may be glorified in the Son. If you ask anything in My name, I will do it.”*

**Hebrews 12:12,13** Therefore, **we lift up our hands that are weak and strengthen our knees that are feeble.** We make straight paths for our feet so that when we are lame we may not stumble and be disabled, **but rather be healed.**

**James 5:14-16** Am I sick? Then I will call for the elders of the church, and **let them pray over me, anointing me with oil in the Name of the LORD.** And **the prayer of faith will restore me when I am sick,** and **the LORD will raise me up.** And if I have sinned, I will be forgiven. I will confess my sins to another, and we will pray for each other, **so that we may be healed.** Our effectual fervent prayer as righteous ones accomplishes much.

**Matthew 18:18-20** You said to us that whatever we bind on earth will be bound in Heaven, and whatever we loose on earth will be loosed in Heaven. ... and that if two of us agree on earth concerning anything that we ask, it will be done for us by Your Father in Heaven. For where two or three of us are gathered together in Your Name, You are here in the midst of us.

**Mark 11:22-24** Jesus, You said: *“Have faith in GOD. For truly I say to you that if you say to this mountain, ‘Be moved and be cast into the sea,’ and shall not doubt in your heart, but shall believe that what you say shall occur, you shall have whatever you say. Therefore I say to you, All things, whatever you ask, praying, believe that you shall receive them, and you shall have them.”*

**Luke 11:9,10** LORD, You said to keep asking and it shall be given me. Keep seeking and I shall find. Keep knocking and it shall be opened to me.

**John 15:7,8** If I abide in You, Jesus, and Your Words abide in me, You say I shall ask what I desire, and it shall be done to me. In this Your Father is glorified, that I bear much fruit, so shall I be Your disciple.

**1 John 3:19-22** I will not love in word or with my tongue only, but in deed and in truth. And by this I shall know that I am of the truth, and shall assure my heart before You, LORD, that if my heart accuses and condemns me, GOD, You are greater than my heart and know all things.... If my heart does not accuse and condemn me, I have confidence toward You, GOD. And whatever I ask, I receive from You, because I reverence and keep Your commandments and do those things that are pleasing in Your sight.

**1 John 5:14,15** And this is the confidence that I have toward You, GOD, that if I ask anything according to Your Will, You hear me. And if I know that You hear me, whatever I ask, I know that I have the petitions that I have desired of You.

**1 Thessalonians 5:16-18** Therefore I will **rejoice** evermore. I will **pray** without ceasing. In everything I will **give thanks**, for this is Your Will, O GOD, in Christ Jesus concerning me!
